FlexiGlue: Method and Procedure



Take 6g (No. 10 NL Size Guide) of Sugarin NL FlexiPaste and place into a small microwave safe rounded container or bowl.

Add 2.5 ml (1/2 teaspoon) of hot water from tap, microwaved or from a tea kettle. It does not need to be boiling, just hot. Pour on top of the paste and place into microwave for 10 seconds.

Using a small spatula or pallet knife, mix together and then using pallet knife, blend to make as smooth of a slurry as possible. Transfer the mixture to work surface and paddle until smooth.

Transfer mixture back into the bowl and add another 1/2 teaspoon hot water and mix well.

Take 50ml (1/4 cup/2 fl. oz.) hot water, and add a little of the hot water at a time, mixing well after each addition, very much like making a roux. Mix well with a small whisk after each addition of hot water.

Place into a microwave safe container, like a glass Pyrex measuring cup, and microwave on high full power for 20 seconds. Using a whisk, stir well then microwave for another 30 seconds to boil the mixture. This will cause the mixture to become thick like a custard or gravy.

Carefully remove from the microwave and add three (3) drops of NL Extend-It (Potassium Sorbate solution/Mold Inhibitor) mix thoroughly and strain using a tea strainer or small sieve into a air-tight container with a lid. Ensure the container is clean. The FlexiGlue Pot container is excellent for this.

The large 2 oz. pot container can be used for long term storage of the FlexiGlue, while the small 1 oz. FlexiGlue container is ideal for use on your flower making station.

Note: Store at ambient room temperature or if you have not used the NL Extend-It in the recipe, the FlexiGlue will need to be stored in the refrigerator.

*FlexiGlue is recommended to be use with the NL FlexiPaste by "Sugarin" to enable items to remain flexible when using FlexiPaste for creating flowers, making bows, dressing figures, etc.
